 \checkmark How big are the classes?

 \checkmark (Ask Students) How easy is it to meet with faculty?

 \checkmark (Ask Students) Are you able to register for the classes you want?

 \checkmark What is the total cost of attending the college?

 \checkmark What types of financial aid does the college offer and how do I apply?

 \checkmark Are all freshman assigned to an academic advisor?

 \checkmark Where do most freshman live? Where are they able to live- off campus? How do I learn about the different hall options?

√Can I take a tour?

 \checkmark What activities are available for students? What do people do on the weekends?

 \checkmark Are there student employment opportunities on campus?

 \checkmark How successful are the college's graduates in finding jobs?

 \checkmark Do you have a career center? What can the career center offer me?

 \checkmark What services (such as transportation and shopping) are available locally?

 \checkmark What is there to do on the weekends? Do most students stay or leave campus on weekends?

 \sqrt{I} want to major in ______. Can I set up a meeting to talk to someone in that department?

 \checkmark Is there a fee to use the technology department is my computer needs fixed?

 \checkmark What accreditations has your school earned? Who do I contact to find out what accreditations my program might have?

 \checkmark Does your school offer application fee waivers to students for visiting?

- \checkmark Where is tutoring offered on campus and how often are they available?
- \checkmark What accommodations exist on you campus for classes, for student that need extra help?
- \checkmark What test is need for you college entrance and what are the minimum score?
- ✓ What services/ programs does the college provide through their disability support office or other offices that handle disability accommodations?
- ✓ How often are special service available? Are the services provided on campus or available on as as- needed basis?
- \checkmark Are there restrictions (e.g. times per week) or additional cost for using these services?
- ✓ Makes sure you meet with a member of Special services at the college to understand the accommodations that can be provided to you and how you should access them.
