

Questions to Assist in College Selection

When trying to decide which college is the best fit for you, consider asking these questions:

- ✓What activities and services are available to help students get settled (academically and socially) during their first year?
- ✓How big are the classes?
- ✓(Ask Students) How easy is it to meet with faculty?
- ✓(Ask Students) Are you able to register for the classes you want?
- ✓What is the total cost of attending the college?
- ✓What types of financial aid does the college offer and how do I apply?
- ✓Are all freshman assigned to an academic advisor?
- ✓Where do most freshman live? Where are they able to live- off campus? How do I learn about the different hall options?
- ✓Can I take a tour?
- ✓What activities are available for students? What do people do on the weekends?
- ✓Are there student employment opportunities on campus?
- ✓How successful are the college's graduates in finding jobs?
- ✓Do you have a career center? What can the career center offer me?
- ✓What services (such as transportation and shopping) are available locally?
- ✓What is there to do on the weekends? Do most students stay or leave campus on weekends?
- ✓I want to major in _____. Can I set up a meeting to talk to someone in that department?
- ✓Is there a fee to use the technology department is my computer needs fixed?
- ✓What accreditations has your school earned? Who do I contact to find out what accreditations my program might have?
- ✓Does your school offer application fee waivers to students for visiting?
- ✓ Where is tutoring offered on campus and how often are they available?
- ✓ What accommodations exist on you campus for classes, for student that need extra help?
- ✓ What test is need for you college entrance and what are the minimum score?
- ✓ What services/ programs does the college provide through their disability support office or other offices that handle disability accommodations?
- ✓ How often are special service available? Are the services provided on campus or available on as as- needed basis?
- ✓ Are there restrictions (e.g. times per week) or additional cost for using these services?
- ✓ Makes sure you meet with a member of Special services at the college to understand the accommodations that can be provided to you and how you should access them.
