

# SOCSS Worksheet - Playground Example

<p><b>Situation</b></p> <p><b>Who:</b> Cameron and me</p> <p><b>When:</b> During recess</p> <p><b>What:</b> I pushed Cameron off of the swing</p> <p><b>Why:</b> I was upset because I wanted a turn to swing and was tired of waiting</p> <p><b>Where:</b> On the playground</p>		
<p><b>Desired Outcome:</b></p>		
<b>Options</b>	<b>Consequences</b>	<b>Choices</b>
1. Wait for Cameron to get off of the swing	I could be waiting the entire recess period for a swing	Fourth Choice
2. Ask Cameron for a turn to swing	Cameron could say "no"	Third Choice
3. Ask the playground monitor for a turn to swing	The playground monitor would tell Cameron how much longer he has to swing and when it is my turn	First Choice
4. Go play on the jungle gym	I could swing from the monkey bars instead	Second Choice
<p><b>Strategy: Action Plan (choose the option)</b></p> <p>Choice Three - When I go outside for recess and want to swing on the swings, I need to go right away to the playground monitor and ask her to help me get a turn on the swings.</p>		
<b>Simulation</b>	<b>Select One</b>

<p><b>Simulation Outcomes</b></p> <p>Use a help card to take turns by handing help card to adult each time I am wanting a turn</p>
