<p>Situation: Who: Cameron and me When: During recess on the playground What: I pushed Cameron off of the swing Why: I was upset because he wanted a turn to swing and was tired of waiting Where</p>		
<p>Desired Outcome:</p>		
Options	Consequences	Choices
1. Wait for Cameron to get off of the swing	I could be waiting the entire recess period for a swing	Fourth Choice
2. Ask Cameron for a turn to swing	Cameron could say "no"	Third Choice
3. Ask the playground monitor for a turn to swing	The playground monitor would tell Cameron how much longer he has to swing and when it is my turn	First Choice
4. Go play on the jungle gym	I could swing from the monkey bars instead	Second Choice
<p>Strategy: Action Plan (choose the option) Choice Three - When I go outside for recess and want to swing on the swings, I need to go right away to the playground monitor and ask her to help me get a turn on the swings.</p>
